Prepare a short note on different departments and institutions working for the protection of Consumer Interest.

Answer: Consumer Interest: Short note and relevant facts are:

Direct Issue: A direct tax can be defined as a tax that is paid directly by an individual or organization to the taxing authority (generally government). A direct tax cannot be shifted to another individual or entity. The individual or organization upon which the tax is levied is responsible for the payment of the tax payment.

Indirect Issue: The tax levied on the sale of goods and services is the indirect tax. An indirect tax is levied on the sale of goods and services for GDP. It is levied on the manufacturer (such as a retailer) rather than the person who bears the ultimate economic burden of the tax (such as the consumer).
