The framework emphasizes the importance of inclusive education, which includes the recognition and inclusion of indigenous peoples' and local communities' diverse worldviews, values, and knowledge systems. It acknowledges the need for balanced access to tools and technologies related to medicinal products, vaccines, and other healthcare products that are relevant to biodiversity conservation and aims to reduce the risks associated with environmental degradation while promoting sustainable development. The Aichi-Biodiversity Framework is a crucial component in achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which include all three dimensions of SDGs: environment, society, and economy. The framework's goals and targets can only be achieved by considering these three dimensions as interconnected components that create a synergistic effect. The Aichi-Biodiversity Framework also acknowledges the importance of recognizing the relationship between biodiversity and cultural diversity, which is essential for sustainable development. It aims to promote the fair and equitable distribution of benefits arising from the use of genetic resources and traditional knowledge, creating a more inclusive and equitable approach to biodiversity conservation and sustainable development. Finally, the Aichi-Biodiversity Framework recognizes the need for urgent policy actions at all levels to achieve the vision of 2050, where humans live in harmony with nature. This requires world, regional, and national governments to take immediate action to address the biodiversity crisis and promote sustainable development. Kyoto City has been working on its Biodiversity Plan since 2015, aiming to protect ecosystems and promote biodiversity awareness through various initiatives. However, despite these efforts, the city still faces challenges such as the decline of native species that support its unique culture, deforestation, and the impacts of climate change. To address these issues, Kyoto City aims to develop a more comprehensive Biodiversity Plan (2021-2030) that promotes biodiversity conservation and sustainable development. The plan's goal is to create a "Natural Coexistence Society" where humans live in harmony with nature.
