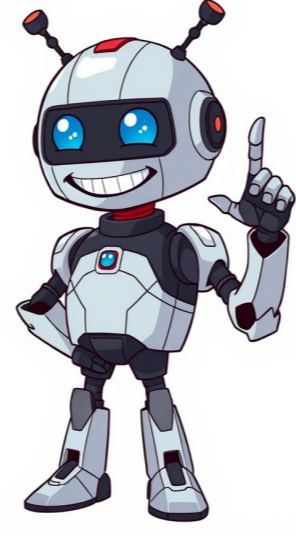

Learn More Contact Us Cambridge is 30 miles (48km) from Stansted Airport, which serves more than 140 global destinations, and 38 miles (61km) from London Luton Airport. The direct train from Stansted Airport to Cambridge takes around 30 minutes with Greater Anglia. Coach travel is also available from Stansted to Cambridge, taking around 40 minutes with National Express. For those arriving into London Heathrow Airport, coaches to Cambridge take around two hours, or if you're arriving into Gatwick Airport, you can take a train to Cambridge in around two hours too. The faster trains from London Kings Cross to Cambridge take around 50 minutes with Great Northern trains, while hourly services from London Liverpool Street with Greater Anglia take slightly longer. If you're travelling through Cambridgeshire, join the longest busway in the world: the Cambridgeshire Guided Busway which connects Cambridge with surrounding areas such as St Ives, Huntingdon and Trumpington. Getting around Once you're in Cambridge, the best way to explore is on foot, although there is a wealth of reliable public transport options too. If you decided to see the spectacular Ely Cathedral, trains north from Cambridge to Ely take 15-20 minutes.
