Rev has specific guidelines for formatting work, which can be found in their Style Guide. Adhering to these guidelines is vital, as incorrect labeling or missing punctuation can lead to penalties in the Formatting metric. Before submitting your application test, ensure that your transcription or caption work adheres to the specified formatting rules. This particular metric only applies if you're applying for a captioner position, not transcribers. The key here is to attentively listen and press the right keyboard key to align accurate captions at the correct moment. If captions are placed two seconds before or after the speaker's words, points may be deducted from the Alignment metric. In this final test section, you'll practice either transcribing or captioning. Rev will provide a video or audio clip that needs to be accurately transcribed or captioned. Pay close attention to what you're doing during this practice session, as it might seem straightforward but can make all the difference in producing high-quality work. To maintain focus while transcribing or captioning, consider these tips: * Close unnecessary tabs and programs on your computer. * Use earphones instead of relying on speakers. * Create a quiet atmosphere around you. * If needed, relocate to a quieter room before starting work. * Avoid distractions like singing, humming, or whistling. * Understand the context of what's being transcribed or captioned. * Listen carefully if words typed don't make sense: it might be due to similar-sounding words.
