Ever since 2017 when Yahoo was purchased by Verizon, the site has increasingly got worse and worse. In 2018, they shut down Messenger and gave the most generic reason to why. Instead of improving it and making it like Google Chat, they just shut it down, opened another service like it, and then shut that down too and gave no reason. In 2016, they shut down Yahoo Games and gave the same stupid vague reason like they later did with Messenger. Here are the problems I run into: -in Firefox, loading comments, causes page to reload, and I never see comments. -in Edge (the latest one), ads cover up the "Send" button on the comment box. -If someone replies to one of my comments, I get a reply in my email, but when I try to visit the link and type a reply, the page reloads and collapses the comment section before I even get a chance to type. This happens in Edge. This problem started happening about a month ago. Whenever I open a new Chrome window or tab, in both a regular window and incognito window, instead of binging me to the google search page, it brings me directly to the yahoo search page. Whenever I go to do a search it always defaults to Yahoo. Ive gone through all my settings. I've added chrome as my home page, default browser, I even have it set as the specific page to open on start up, but every single time I add a new tab it goes directly to yahoo. I even went as far as deleting Chrome and re downloading it, but that still did nothing. I am using a MacBook Air running macOS Catalina 10.15.6. Hi all, When I open a new tab (or use an existing one) to search for something, I get redirected to Yahoo search.I'm having this problem for 2 months now I think, even though I haven't downloaded any suspicious lately I can't find out what the cause is. I don't get any other weird things like a changed homepage or random tabs, just the once in a while Yahoo redirect instead Google search The things I tried:- Deleting my cache/cookies etc.- Looked at my recently installed programs (nothing suspicious)- Ran multiple scans (Avast, Hitman, Malwarebytes, no results except for a few cookies which I deleted)- Reinstalled Chrome- Ran a scan via Chrome, no results I also looked at my default search engine and it never said Yahoo, so it looks like my browser gets hijacked sometimes. Not all the time, just once in a while. It's not a big problem but I know something's wrong so I'd rather solve it : Specs:- Windows 10, 64 bits- Chrome Version 80.0.3987.162 (Official build) (64-bits)Extensions:- AdBlock- Avast- Ratings Preview for YouTubeI've been using these plugins before I had this problem so I don't think it has to do with those. Does anyone know what might be wrong or how to solve this browser hijacking? I tried multiple things using common sense and searching the web but it didn't help -edit- I just looked at the Ratings Preview extension and it seems removed from the Chrome store (error 404), maybe the developer of this plugin is injecting some malware in Chrome? I will run Chrome without it for now, if anyone else knows a solution please tell! :Even though the plugin I was using looks 99% identical to this one weird thing is when I try to install the plugin using their own site I get a 404 ( ) Message u/Yahoo-CustomerCare for Yahoo Support, or visit Help.Yahoo.com for official support channels. For the most part this all works fine, Chrome (both mobile and desktop) have no problems whatsoever, and I can also access it normally using Edge's InPrivate mode But using Edge's "default" mode (not InPrivate) the login.yahoo.com will always redirect to the domain att-yahoo.att.net, which then redirects a second time to signin.att.com. This is a problem because I CANNOT access yahoo mail accounts through AT&T logins, they will throw error code 201 (login credentials not recognized) Adding the AT&T domains to Edge's "block these websites" settings doesn't help Is there any way to force Edge to go to the Yahoo domain, and reject redirects to the AT&T domain? For months, my Yahoo! e-mail (in a browser) is slower than ever, taking many seconds to do ANYTHING. I spend a majority of my time moving items from my Inbox into folders; I select one-or-more items, hit CTRL+D to bring up the list of folders, and then select the folder. One HUGE problem is that it takes several seconds to bring up the list of folders, and then often when it's displayed, I'll hit a key to jump to the folders starting with that letter (for example, I'll hit "P" to move to the folders starting with the letter "P"), but the background key handler misinterprets that as "Print", which completely screws up everything. Adding insult-to-injury, my (Google Chrome browser) constantly displays the following pop-up. Page Unresponsive You can wait for it to become responsive or exit the page. I found and tried many suggestions to disable that pop-up in Chrome, and nothing worked. I contacted Yahoo! Support, which was a joke, because after several weeks it became clear that they were only interested in pointing fingers at other things that might be causing it, instead of acknowledging the clear design flaw in Yahoo! Mail. I don't see the pop-up in Firefox, but it's still horrifically slow -- worse than in Chrome. Still, that's not my question. To anyone out there, do you know of a way to use Yahoo! E-mail (in a browser) that has usable responsiveness? I can't imagine why they think that it's okay (much less charge for "Premium"), but I guess they're getting away with it.
