Whoever saved you, I love them. Agnarr: I wish I knew who it was. Elsa: What happen to the spirits? What's in the Forest now? Agnarr: I don't no. The mist stil stands. No one can get in, and no one has since come out. Iduna: So we're safe. Agnarr: Yes, but the forest could wake again, and we must be prepared for whatever danger it may bring. Iduna: And on that note, how about we say goodnight to your father? Anna: Oh, but I still have so many questions! Agnarr: Save them for another night, Anna. Anna: Ugh, you know I don't have that kind of patience. Why did the Northuldra attack us anyway? Who attacks people who gave them gifts? Elsa: Do you think the forest will wake again? Iduna: Only Ahtohallan knows. Anna: "Ahtoha--" what? Iduna: When I was little... my mother would sing a song about special river, called Ahtohallan... that was said to hold all the answers about the past, about what we are apart of. Anna: Wow. Elsa: Will you sing it for us? Please? Iduna: Okay, cuddle close. Scooch in. Where the northwind meets the sea There's a mother full of memory Come my darling, homeward bound When all is lost, then all is found Ends (In the present day, both Anna and Elsa are now grown up, since their parents' mysterious and tragic death and Hans' defeat since the events of Frozen. Elsa looks out into the balcony, when Kai interrupts her peace time) Kai: Your Majesty? Elsa: Oh! Kai: They're ready. Elsa: (Chuckles nervously) Excuse me, I'm coming. (hears a voice) Do you hear that? Kai: Uh, what? Elsa: Never mind. Anna: (chuckling) Enjoying your new Permafrost, Olaf? Olaf: I'm just living the dream Anna. Oh, how I wish this could last forever. Anna: Mmmm... Anna: What's that? Olaf: Forgive me, maturity is making me poetic. Tell me, you're older and thus all-knowing. Anna: Uh... no. Olaf: Really? Wow, I can't wait till I'm aged like you, so I don't have to worry about important things. Anna: That's not what I mean. (Townspople) Ah ah ah ah ah ah The wind blows a little bit colder (Olaf) And you all look a little bit older (Anna) It's time to count our blessings (Anna & Kristoff) Beneath an autumn sky (Townspople) We'll always live in a kingdom of plenty That stands for the good and the many (Elsa) And I promise you the flag of Arendelle will always fly (Anna) Our flag will always fly! (Townspople) Our flag will always fly! (Townspople) Some things never change Turn around and time has flown Some things stay the same Though the future remains unknown May our good luck last, may our past be past Time's moving fast, it's true (Elsa, Anna, & Kristoff) Some things never change (Anna) And I'm holding on tight to you (Elsa) Holding on tight to you (Olaf) Holding on tight to you (Kristoff) Elsa sat on the couch, observing her sister Anna making silly faces while Kristoff and Olaf tried to guess the object she was thinking of. Sven held a bell in his mouth, adding to the comedic atmosphere. Meanwhile, Elsa's eyes seemed distant. "Villain!" someone suddenly shouted, and Elsa smiled weakly. The game continued, with Olaf rearranging the categories and making it a "lightning round." Kristoff confidently declared that they would win, but when Elsa took her turn, she seemed uncertain. What do you want? Cause you've been keeping me awake Are you here to distract me so I make a big mistake? Or are you someone out there who's a little bit like me? Who knows deep down I'm not where I meant to be? Elsa: Air, fire, water, earth. (Thunder rumbling, shattering, flashing) Anna: The water! (Wind howling) Elsa: They're outrageous! No fire, no water, the earth is next. We have to get out! It'll be okay, evacuate to the cliffs! Olaf: Oh no, I'm gonna blow! Kristoff: - I got you! (Everyone evacuated) Anna: Okay, I don't understand. You've been hearing a voice and you didn't think to tell? Elsa: I didn't wanna worry you. Anna: We made a promise not to shut each other out! Just tell me what's going on! Elsa: I woke the magical spirits of the Enchanted Forest. Anna: Okay, that's definitely not what what I thought you were gonna say. Wait, the Enchanted Forest? The one father warned us about? Elsa: Yes. Anna: Why would you do that? Elsa: Because of the voice. I know it sounds crazy, but I believe whoever is calling me is good. Anna: How can you say that? Look at our kingdom! Elsa: I know, it's just that my magic can feel it. I can feel it. Grand Pabbie warns Anna and Elsa that Arendelle is in danger and they must find the truth to ensure a future. Anna insists on joining Elsa, despite her lack of powers, while Kristoff agrees to drive them to the Enchanted Forest. Olaf offers snacks for their journey. Grand Pabbie promises to keep the kingdom safe until they return. In flashbacks, the story of King Agnarr and his people is revealed. As Elsa's 16th birthday approaches, the kingdom celebrates, unaware that she has been living in secret with good friends who have raised her as one of their own. The group plans a surprise party for her special day. During the journey, Kristoff shares his knowledge, claiming that sleeping in quietly on long journeys prevents insanity. Olaf questions this, but Elsa and Anna confirm it's true. The trio then discusses love, with Kristoff reminding Anna that she was once naive about relationships. Anna and Elsa find themselves lost in the Enchanted Forest, where they encounter a mysterious fog. As they try to navigate through it, Kristoff and Olaf join them, and they all enter the fog together. However, they soon realize that they are trapped, and the Wind Spirit pushes them out of the foggy area. Anna expresses her concern about the dam in Grand Pabbie's visions, which could break and cause a tidal wave that would wash away everything on the fjord, including Arendelle. Kristoff reassures her that nothing will happen to their town and tries to lighten the mood by suggesting that this could be a romantic spot under different circumstances. Anna becomes worried about their chances of survival, but Kristoff tries to reassure her that they will make it out alive. However, Olaf becomes increasingly agitated as he realizes that they might die at some point in the future, and Anna vows not to leave Elsa's side. As they try to escape the forest, Olaf becomes convinced that everything will make sense when he is older and more mature. He believes that growing up means adapting to new situations and finding one's place in the world. Despite his initial fears, Olaf finds comfort in knowing that everything will become clear as he grows older. Olaf exclaimed, "Hey guys, meet the wind spirit!" as Kristoff whizzed past with the strong gusts. Anna looked queasy and said she might get sick. Meanwhile, Elsa noticed a branch heading straight for her sister but skillfully deflected it. The Wind Spirit started playing with Elsa's hands, causing her to react. Mattias: "Perhaps we can learn more from this mysterious voice." Yelana: "Why would nature reward us with magic if our people are innocent?" Mattias: "Maybe the truth will reveal itself when we least expect it." Suddenly, a new character appears: Lieutenant Mattias! Anna: "That's him! Our father's official guard!" Mattias: "I see Agnarr in your faces. What happened to your parents?" Anna: "Their ship sank six years ago." The Northuldra are cornered until Elsa intervenes: "Wait, I think nature is trying to tell us something. If we can just find it..." Yelana rejects her plan, but the Fire Spirit appears, and Elsa blasts ice at it. Kristoff: "Hey, reindeer! Come on!" Anna follows Elsa into the fire, where they encounter a salamander, which turns out to be the Fire Spirit. The forest is saved, but now Elsa is left with more questions than answers: "Who's calling us? What do we do next?" The voice calls again, and Elsa wonders if she should know what it means. Elsa and Anna reunited at the meeting point. Elsa's eyes locked onto her sister as she emerged from the flames. Anna rushed to Elsa, embracing her tightly. Elsa apologized for putting Anna in danger. Anna stated that she'd been through better, but thanked Elsa for being cautious. Elsa revealed she had found an old scarf with significance and wrapped it around Anna. The scarf belonged to their mother, who was also a Northuldra. Anna shared the story of how their mother saved her father's life that day, which brought back memories for both sisters. The Northuldra people surrounded them, singing and forming a spiral around the sisters. Ryder introduced himself and explained why he was there, and Kristoff joined in. Elsa heard a familiar voice again, signaling they needed to proceed north. Honeymaren advised they should leave at dawn, but warned about the roaming Earth Giants. Meanwhile, Olaf interacted with the Northuldra children, discussing maturity and its challenges. Kristoff reveals his plans to propose to Anna, but Ryder informs him that she's actually gone with Elsa. Disheartened, Kristoff decides to head west with Yelana to the Lycan Meadows. Reindeers are better than people. Sven says in Kristoff's mind. He asks why love is so hard, and Sven responds by telling him to let down his guard and feel what he feels. Kristoff starts singing again, this time about being lost in the woods and feeling disconnected from someone he cares about. The lyrics describe feelings of uncertainty, confusion, and longing. As Kristoff continues to sing, flashbacks from their past adventures play out, showing moments where they've been together and apart. He questions his identity without this person by his side and wonders if he's lost without them. In the present, Kristoff feels like he's turned around and can't find his way because of their separation. The song ends with Kristoff feeling heartbroken and lost in the woods, unsure of what path to take or how to move forward. As he sings about being lost, the scene shifts to Elsa and Anna, who are searching for clues to a mysterious voice. They come across a sunken ship that leads them to a map with cryptic messages from Kristof's parents. The map seems to point to Ahtohallan, a magical river said to hold answers about the past. Elsa's sources and her connection to this place are revealed, leaving Anna and Elsa in awe of what they've discovered. I wanna know what happened to them - Ahtohallan is the source of the magic - We keep going For Elsa ... Waves are too high! Elsa. She was looking for answers about us. You are not responsible for their choices, Elsa. No, just their deaths. Stop. Yelana asks why would the spirit reward Arendelle with the magical queen? Because our mother saved her father. She saved her enemy! Her good deed was rewarded With you - You are a gift. I believe in you Elsa, more than anyone or anything. Honeymaren said there was a fifth spirit. A bridge between magical nature and us - That what's been calling me From Ahtohallan! The answers about the past are all there. So, we go to Ahtohallan? Not we, Me. The dark sea is too dangerous for us both. No, we do this together. Remember the song, "Go too far and you'll be drowned"? Who will stop you from going too far? You said you believed in me that this is what I was born to do. And I don't want to stop you from that. I just don't want you dying, trying to be everything for everyone else too. Don't do this alone. Let me help you, please. I'm sensing some rising anger - Ah, Oh, I am angry, Olaf! She pushed me away too and Didn't even say goodbye And you have every right to be very, very mad at her Since then Everything done's nothing but change But look I'm still here holding your hand You're such a good listener. Shh, shh, shh! Look! The Giants are huge Hang on Olaf! Try not to scream Found it Thank you. Where are we? In a pit, with no way out But with this spooky pitch black way in Come on, it'll be fun Assuming we don't get stuck here forever and no one ever find us You started it and I gave up But bright side Elsa gotta be all out better than we are Of course...! Glaciers are rivers of ice! Ahtohallan is frozen... (Vocalizing) I hear you, and I'm coming... She stood frozen, a statue of ice, her body trapped by the Dam's dark magic. "I know how to free the forest," King Runeard said, his voice laced with sorrow. "But Arendelle will be flooded. That's why everyone was forced out." Olaf tried to offer comfort, but Elsa's eyes had turned into a deep well of despair. "What's this?" he asked, as if searching for a way to restore the princess. Anna: I'm sorry I left you behind. I was just so desperate to protect her. Kristoff: I know, I know, it's okay. My love is not fragile. Ryder: Look at the sky. I just didn't realize there so much of it. Mattias: 34 years... Yelena: 5 months... Mattias: And 23 days. (The reindeer move out in freedom, while Gale signals to Anna that her sister has returned) Elsa is back and things are moving forward for Arendelle. Kristoff shows his love for Anna by proposing to her, which she happily accepts. Anna's sister Elsa also opens up about her feelings and apologizes for her past mistakes. The sisters reconcile and move forward together. Olaf's innocence and determination play a crucial role in the story's resolution.
