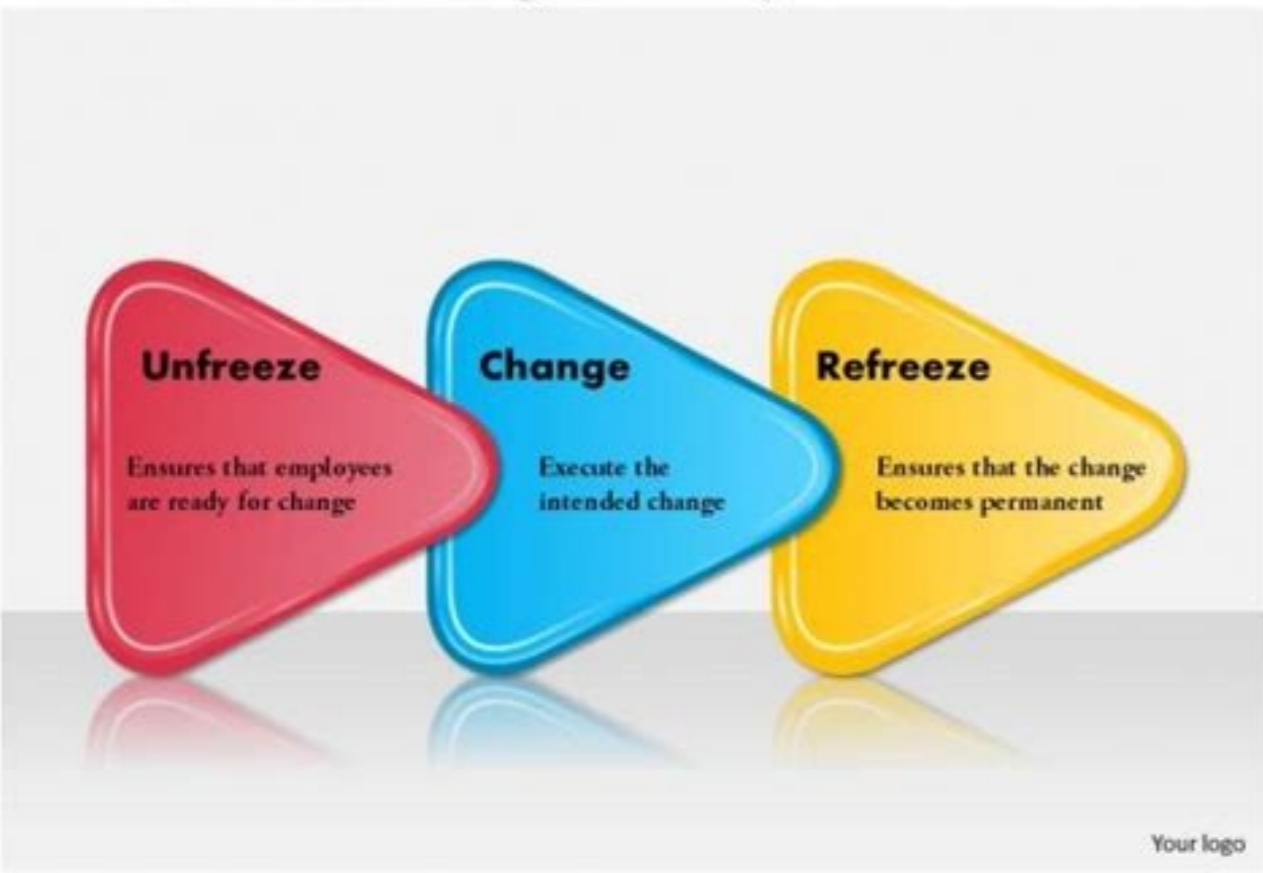
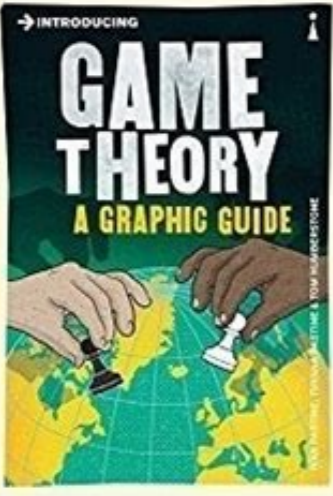

Strategic form of the game

We can analyze the game by listing the players' possible actions (release in October or in December) and payoffs (revenues) in a table, called the **strategic form** (or **normal form**) of the game. The strategic form of a game is a table which is also known as a **payoff matrix**.

Each row represents one possible choice for Rabbit Films - October or December - and each column represents the possible choices for Weasel Studios. At the intersection of each row and column we put the payoffs for each player: in this example, the payoffs are the studios' revenues.

The matrix gives all possible outcomes of the game and specifies what each player would receive as a payoff in those outcomes. Both studios understand the payoff matrix and are aware that they both face the same matrix.

Payoffs

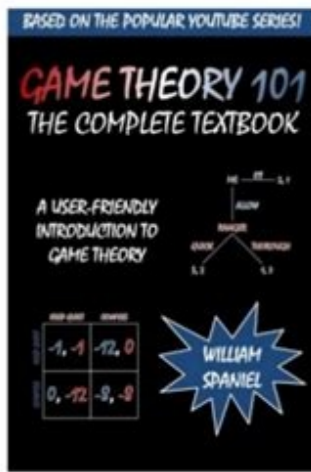
The meaning of payoff numbers varies depending on the problem being analyzed. In the movie release example, the payoff numbers are the revenue the movies are expected to generate (in millions of pounds) in each of the possible outcomes.

In other applications, the payoff numbers will have other interpretations. In biology, they are often the "fitness" of the player, where fitness is related to the chance of the animal reproducing and perpetuating the species. In many applications in economics, sociology, etc., the payoff numbers represent the relative "happiness" or "utility" of the players.
